Dear Mr. Renfro:

Thank you for choosing to operate your aeromedical emergency services operation at McKinney National Airport.

In accordance with the requirements and provisions of Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 773.0573, this letter serves as approval for Dale Aviation/Medical Air Rescue Company ("MARC") to operate as an emergency medical services operator at McKinney National Airport, which is located in McKinney, Texas. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas (the "City"), which is the governing body for the City, has determined that: (1) the addition of MARC will not interfere with or adversely affect the provision of emergency medical services by the licensed emergency medical services providers operating in the City, (2) the addition of MARC will remedy an existing provider shortage that cannot be resolved through the use of the licensed emergency medical services providers operating in the City, and (3) the addition of MARC will not cause an oversupply of licensed emergency medical services providers in the City.

Furthermore, in accordance with City of McKinney Code of Ordinances, Section 30-270 (Aero-medical Operator - SASO) and Article 4 B (Use of Premises) of the Lease and Operating Agreement between CCHOA and the City of McKinney, this letter serves as approval to operate as an Emergency Medical Services Provider/Aero-Medical Operator from CCHOA Hangar Number 10, so long as MARC is in compliance with the CCHOA Lease and Operating Agreement and is properly certificated, licensed and insured in accordance with all appropriate federal, state and local standards, codes, statutes, laws and regulations.
