




Performance — Fuel Sales by Gallon

A 13% INCREASE COMPARED TO FY18







Performance — Fuel Revenue

New FBO/Terminal Status

- CONSTRUCTION CURRENTLY PAUSED
 - City is working with Owner and Bank to restructure financing
- AIRPORT PAYS NO RENT UNTIL PROJECT IS COMPLETE
- ESTIMATE ADDITIONAL 5-6 MONTHS TO COMPLETE ONCE CONSTRUCTION RESUMES
- Delayed completion is not adversely impacting our customers
- ADDITIONAL VEHICLE PARKING SPACES ARE COMPLETE






AERONAUTICAL DEVELOPMENT

- EXECUTED LEASE FOR BUILDOUT OF 2,600 SF OFFICE
 SPACE FOR EMERGENCY TRANSPORT CREW QUARTERS
- EXECUTED \$400,000 GRANT WITH TXDOT FOR AIRFIELD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS
- EXECUTED GROUND LEASE FOR CCHOA NORTH HANGAR DEVELOPMENT
- CIRRUS TEMPORARY MAINTENANCE REPAIR OVERHAUL (MRO) FACILITY
- COMPLETED CONSTRUCTION OF 40,000 SF TRANSIENT HANGAR
- Secured \$15 Million Grant for Runway Extension

Transient Hangar Revenue | May 2019 – Jan 2020



UPCOMING AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT

CCHOA North

- MNA Development to build a new Private Executive Hangar Development
 - Total of ten (10) executive hangars | Each hangar to be 65' X 62' (4,032 SF)
 - This project will create an economic impact of more than \$6,600,000 to the community





CIRRUS MRO

- Cirrus Aircraft to build a new Aircraft Maintenance and Repair Facility
 - Estimated \$8,000,000 in capital improvements (hangars, ramp, & administrative building)
 - Additional ten (10) FTE positions (for a total of 35 FTE positions on airport)




STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

- AIRPORT AND CITY STAFF AND MAYOR FULLER VISIT FAA OFFICE OF PLANNING AND PROGRAMMING IN WASHINGTON, D.C. TO DISCUSS McKINNEY NATIONAL AIRPORT'S CAPITAL PROGRAM AND FUNDING NEEDS IN THE 1-5 YEAR RANGE
- MEETINGS WITH U.S. CUSTOMS OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS SITE PLAN AND BUILDING PLAN FOR FUTURE CUSTOMS
 FACILITY
- VARIOUS VISITS WITH TXDOT OFFICE OF AVIATION REGARDING PENDING AND ACTIVE GRANTS

 - Preferred alternative determination
 - Environmental assessment
 - Design
- CIRRUS AIRCRAFT
 - Finalize ground lease
 - Commence construction on permanent facilities
- Appraisal of Ground Rent and Hangar Lease Rates
- ADD 30,000 GALLON JET A FUEL STORAGE TANK
