ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONES FOR EMERSON HIGH SCHOOL IN McKINNEY, TEXAS; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 230, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-230. Emerson High School – Zone Designated.

The Emerson High School zone shall be:

- (1) On Eastbound Collin McKinney Parkway beginning at a point 940 feet east of Stars Avenue and extending eastward along Collin McKinney Parkway to a point 435 feet west of Stacy Road.
- (2) On Westbound Collin McKinney Parkway beginning at a point 295 feet west of Stacy Road and extending westward along Collin McKinney Parkway to a point 1,055 feet east of Stars Avenue.
- (3) On Northbound Stacy Road beginning a point 325 feet south of Recioto Drive and extending northward along Stacy Road to a point 200 feet north of Recioto Drive.
- (4) On Southbound Stacy Road 300 feet north of Recioto Drive and extending southward along Stacy Road to a point 200 feet south of Recioto Drive.
- Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 230.1, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-230.1 Same – Speed.

The speed limit for the vehicles traveling the streets within the Emerson High School zone during the hours of 8:15 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. and 4:10 p.m. to 5:10 p.m., school days, shall be 20 miles per hour maximum.

- Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, after all the necessary signs and markings have been installed, and it is accordingly so ordained.
- Section 4. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).
