Dec 1 - Dec 3

Brewery: Continued framing of mezzanine walls a, install of interior liner panels, electrical panels, overhead copper piping and connections, framing at TapRoom















Dec 5 - 10

Brewery: hanging sheetrock, continue interior liner panels, pulling electrical wire, install overhead piping for water and gas systems, install windows, exterior trim, moving of owner equipment; TapRoom: Demo of existing steel and trusses, erecting metal stud walls at addition











Dec 12 - Dec 17

Tornado warning Dec 13 shut down site for several morning hours; Cleaning site; Brewery: hanging lights, install gutters, grading behind brewery for sidewalk,











Dec 19 - Dec 23

Brewery: continue pulling wire, cold water pipe, gutters and downspouts, install steam pipe, ; TapRoom: install sanitary, plumbing, ductwork for kitchen; Flush FDCs and Fire Lines
