A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO REQUEST THAT TXDOT NOT DEMOLISH THE EXISTING US 75 NORTHBOUND FRONTAGE ROAD BRIDGE OVER WILSON CREEK AND INSTEAD ALLOW IT TO REMAIN FOR CITY USE AS A HIKE AND BIKE TRAIL

- **WHEREAS,** the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, desires have a robust hike and bike trail system; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City has determined that the existing US 75 northbound frontage road bridge over Wilson Creek, if modified for pedestrian and bicycle use only, would be a beneficial addition to the trail system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to request that TxDOT not demolish the existing US 75 northbound frontage road bridge over Wilson Creek and instead allow it to remain for City use as a hike and bike trail.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
