FY2104 Closing Highlights:

- More than 40,000 total visits from Activity and Reservation Guests; Greater enrollment in contracted and open rec activities
- 2014 Total Revenue Increased by 13.5% from 2013 (Program and Rental Fees); Exceeded Revenue projection by 7%
