Junior Players' McKinney Arts Commission Narrative Final Report 2017/2018

In 2017/18 Junior Players continued its program offerings in McKinney by providing 20 after-school sessions at Old Settler's and 10 sessions at McKinney Community Center. One Discover Art program was offered for 5 sessions at McKinney Community Center, one Discover Dance program was offered for 5 sessions at McKinney Community Center, one Discover Art program was offered for 10 sessions at Old Settler's Recreation Center and one Discover Dance program was offered for 10 sessions at Old Settler's Recreation Center. Attendance in all workshops was great and the objectives of each workshop were successfully met.

In the summer of 2018, Junior Players provided 4 Discover Theater camps in McKinney at McKinney Community Center and Old Settler's Recreation Center, 1 in June, 2 in July and 1 in August. These camps are designed to introduce children to basic skills in theater utilizing various theater games and oral communication exercises. The students also put together an original short play that was performed at the summer camps' culminating event called The Festival of Plays. Overall, the children had a very positive experience, and the teaching objectives were successfully met. Also, in the summer of 2018, we held an Advanced Discover Shakespeare workshop at the McKinney Performing Arts Center in June/July.

In Participant Surveys, 79% said they felt more confident speaking in front of others, 72% want to learn more about the arts, 68% reported feeling better about themselves as a result of the program, and 83% want to do more arts. According to parents of McKinney participants, 65% noticed an increase in their child's self-esteem, 65% noticed that their child was more confident speaking in front of others and 100% would recommend our program to a friend.

When asked what students liked most about our classes and camps, participant comments included:

- "That it opened me up." Aryanna, age 11, Discover Shakespeare Camp
- "I discovered more plays that [Shakespeare] wrote." Ava, age 13, Discover Shakespeare Camp
- "I enjoyed that it was fun yet able to learn! We were determined in a way that was enjoyable." Alizza, age 14. Discover Theater Summer Camp
- "I love art and we did clay and the cards" Isabel, age 9, Discover Art
