Approval of the Ordinance

ITEM SUMMARY:

- This Ordinance authorizes the addition of \$15,000 from the Park Construction fund balance to CIP Project PK3240 – Tom Allen, Jr. Park Parking Lot Lighting project.
- With previous actions and administrative transfers this Budget Amendment will bring the total project costs of CIP Project PK3240 – Tom Allen Jr. Park Lighting, to \$25,000.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Security concerns were brought to the attention of the Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Department.
- A public input meeting was held with citizens, police representatives, and the PROS staff to discuss vandal issues and possible solutions.
- It was determined that security lighting may help to alleviate these issues within Tom Allen, Jr. Park.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

 This Ordinance authorizes a CIP budget amendment, transferring \$15,000 from the Park Construction fund balance (PK0000) to the Tom Allen, Jr. Park Parking Lot Lighting Project (PK3240)
