AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CERTAIN BUDGET AMENDMENT PERTAINING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 ANNUAL BUDGET, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CDBG-CV GRANT PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF

WHEREAS, as required by the City Charter, the City Manager has prepared an amendment to a certain budget pertaining to the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Annual Budget, to providing funding for the CDBG-CV grant program and submitted same to the City Council for its approval and a true and correct copy is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. Pursuant to the City Charter requirements of the City of McKinney, Texas, a Budget Amendment pertaining to the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Annual Budget is hereby authorized and approved.
- Section 2. The budget shall be amended by appropriating \$411,328 of Program Year 19 grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund for Housing Services and Health Services to prevent, prepare for, or respond to COVID-19.
- Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
