A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$212,453 WITH KLEINFELDER, INC. FOR MATERIAL TESTING AND BUILDING SYSTEMS COMMISSIONING SERVICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MCKINNEY RANCH PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (WA1626) AND AUTHORIZING ANY SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS UNDER SAID CONTRACT UP TO THE AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF SAID SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS, OF \$235,000

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas has awarded a contract for construction of McKinney Ranch Pump Station Improvements Project (WA1626); and

WHEREAS, material testing and building systems commissioning services are required to ensure the quality of the completed project meets the contract specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from Kleinfelder, Inc. to perform the materials testing and building systems commissioning services during the construction of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in an amount of \$212,453 as well as all required supplemental agreements thereto, with Kleinfelder, Inc. to provide material testing and building systems commissioning services related to the construction of the McKinney Ranch Pump Station Improvements Project (WA1626) for a total aggregate contract amount, inclusive of any supplemental agreements, not to exceed \$235,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
