Subject: Upcoming Closures for U.S. 75 Construction in McKinney

As part of the ongoing TxDOT project to widen U.S. 75 from the Sam Rayburn Tollway (SRT) to White Avenue in McKinney, TxDOT has informed the City of the following closures and traffic switches, all weather permitting:

#### Virginia Parkway Intersection Partially Closed for the Summer

TxDOT will begin construction of the new Virginia Parkway and U.S. 75 intersection on Saturday, June 6. Eastbound and westbound traffic will be reduced to just one lane each way on Virginia Parkway directly underneath U.S. 75. Significant delays are expected. Drivers are strongly encouraged to seek alternate routes. Alternate routes to cross U.S. 75 include U.S. 380, White Avenue, Park View Avenue, and Eldorado Parkway. Alternate routes to travel south on U.S. 75 include Hardin Boulevard and S.H. 5. The new intersection is expected to be open by September 30. See attached map for more information.

#### U.S. 75 Main Lanes to be Closed Overnight, June 4

TxDOT will close the main lanes of U.S. 75 beneath Eldorado Parkway starting at 10 p.m. on Thursday night, June 4, to set beams for the new Eldorado Parkway Bridge. Northbound drivers will be diverted to the frontage road then under Eldorado Parkway then along the frontage road to the entrance ramp near the movie theater. Southbound drivers will be diverted to the frontage road near Rockhill Road then under Eldorado Parkway then along the frontage road to the entrance ramp south of Ridgeview Drive. All lanes will be open again by 6 a.m. the next day.

#### U.S. 75 Main Lane Traffic Switch Saturday, June 6


TxDOT will switch northbound main lane traffic to newly constructed concrete travel lanes starting on Saturday, June 6. After the switch is complete, all northbound entrance and exit ramps south of White Avenue will be complete and open permanently.

### Park View Avenue to be Closed Weekdays Until Friday, June 12

TxDOT will close Park View Avenue directly under U.S. 75 Wednesday through Friday this week from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. and again Monday through Friday next week from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m. to allow bridge construction to continue. During the closures, drivers can cross U.S. 75 at Virginia Parkway and Eldorado Parkway.

As a reminder, this TxDOT construction project to widen U.S. 75 from the SRT to White Avenue in McKinney to four main lanes in each direction and three frontage road lanes in each direction will provide much needed extra capacity through McKinney. The project is anticipated to be complete in January 2016.

As part of the ongoing TxDOT project to widen U.S. 75 from the Sam Rayburn Tollway (SRT) to White Avenue in McKinney, TxDOT has informed the City of the following traffic switch and overnight closure, both weather permitting:

## U.S. 75 Northbound Main Lane Traffic Switch to Happen Tonight, June 9

TxDOT will close the northbound main lanes of U.S. 75 from Eldorado Parkway to U.S. 380 starting at 10 p.m. tonight, June 9, to switch northbound main lane traffic to newly constructed concrete travel lanes. Northbound drivers will be diverted to the frontage road south of Eldorado Parkway then under Eldorado Parkway then through the intersections at Virginia Parkway, White Avenue, and U.S. 380 to the entrance ramp near Bray Central Drive. All lanes are scheduled to be open again by 6 a.m. After the switch is complete, all northbound entrance and exit ramps south of White Avenue will be complete and open permanently.

## U.S. 75 Southbound Main Lane Closure Tonight, June 9

TxDOT will close the southbound main lanes of U.S. 75 beneath Eldorado Parkway starting at 10 p.m. tonight, June 9, to set bridge deck panels for the new Eldorado Parkway Bridge. Southbound drivers will be diverted to the frontage road near Rockhill Road then under Eldorado Parkway then along the frontage road to the entrance ramp south of Ridgeview Drive. All lanes are scheduled to be open again by 6 a.m. tomorrow.

As a reminder, this TxDOT construction project to widen U.S. 75 from the SRT to White Avenue in McKinney to four main lanes in each direction and three frontage road lanes in each direction will provide much needed extra capacity through McKinney. The project is anticipated to be complete in January 2016.

The exact start date will be sent out once it is determined.</u> Eastbound and westbound traffic will be reduced to just one lane each way on Virginia Parkway directly underneath U.S. 75. Significant delays are expected. Drivers are strongly encouraged to seek alternate routes. Alternate routes to cross U.S. 75 include U.S. 380, White Avenue, Park View Avenue, and Eldorado Parkway.
