

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-07- __ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION OF AND ACCEPTANCE, IF AWARDED, OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE 2011 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT, PREPARING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR CERTAIN EXPENDITURES IN THE MCKINNEY POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET, AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AS OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY IN MATTERS RELATING TO THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas recognizes the need for the application for and acceptance of federal funds, allocated to the City of McKinney to assist the McKinney Police Department in enhancing public safety and reducing crime in the City of McKinney; and

WHEREAS, the Justice Assistance Grant funds are allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, to be shared between Collin County, the City of Plano, and the City of McKinney to enhance public safety and reduce crime; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas agrees to enter into an interlocal agreement with Collin County and the City of Plano for the disbursement of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept, if awarded, the U.S. Department of Justice, 2011 Justice Assistance Grant, and prepare a budget amendment for certain expenditures by the McKinney Police Department related to this grant, and handle all matters related to acceptance of said grant.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
