- **WHEREAS,** the McKinney Police Department achieved re-recognized status by the Texas Police Chiefs Association in 2014; and
- whereas, the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., (CALEA) was created in 1979 as an international credentialing authority with the purpose of improving the delivery of law enforcement services; and
- WHEREAS, the accreditation program provides law enforcement agencies an opportunity to voluntarily demonstrate that they meet an established set of nationally recognized professional standards; and
- WHEREAS, the McKinney Police Department underwent its initial on-site assessment in 2016 for accreditation, demonstrating that the policies and operating procedures utilized are in compliance with over 360 applicable standards; and
- WHEREAS, upon conclusion of questioning by the CALEA Commissioners at the hearing in November, it was their unanimous vote to grant the McKinney Police Department accredited status; and
- WHEREAS, along with its initial accreditation, the McKinney Police Department is the third in the State of Texas to hold CALEA accreditation and TPCA recognition simultaneously;
