RE: Modifications of School Zones at Slaughter Elementary School
Carlisle Street and Wolford Street

Dear Mr. Huynh:

This is a letter in support of the modifications proposed of the school zones at Slaughter Elementary School along Carlisle Street and Wolford Street. McKinney ISD (MISD) has removed the school crossing of Virginia Parkway at Carlisle Street from the designated walking route to Slaughter Elementary School and now provides bus service to students needing to cross Virginia Parkway. MISD wants to help discourage speeding close to the school campus where pedestrian activity is concentrated and thus requests that the overall reduced speed school zone on Carlisle Street be modified to protect the student pedestrians and maintain motorist compliance. MISD also requests the reduced speed school zone be extended on Wolford Drive to include the easternmost school drive of Lawson Learning Center. MISD requests that all other school zones for Slaughter Elementary School remain active and unaffected by this modification.

For reference, the school zones along Carlisle Street and Wolford Street proposed to be modified are specifically described in Section 62-268 of the City of McKinney Code of Ordinances. The school zone on Carlisle Street begins at Virginia Parkway and extends to Wolford Street. The school zone on Wolford Street begins at a point 100 feet east of Courtney and extends eastward to a point 510 feet east of Carlisle Street. MISD supports the modifications of these school zones.
