Sec. 146-167. - Historic Preservation Officer.

The <u>Director</u> of <u>Planning</u> shall appoint a <u>professionally</u> qualified staff person to serve as the <u>Historic Preservation Officer</u>. To be professionally qualified, the staff person shall have a bachelor's degree in historic preservation or a related discipline such as urban planning, historic preservation planning, architecture, architectural preservation, <u>architectural history</u>, or historic architecture. The following provisions shall apply to the <u>Historic Preservation Officer</u>:

- (1) The <u>Historic Preservation Officer</u> is responsible for coordinating the city's preservation activities with those of <u>local</u>, state and federal agencies and with local, state and national non-profit preservation organizations.
- (2) The <u>Historic Preservation Officer</u> shall follow <u>The Secretary of the Interior's</u>
 Standards for the Rehabilitation of Historic Buildings in his consideration of all applications for a <u>Certificate</u> of <u>Appropriateness</u> within the <u>H Historic Preservation Overlay District</u>
- (3) The <u>Historic Preservation Officer</u> serves as a non-voting representative to the <u>Historic Preservation Board, advising the board on relevant issues and matters</u> submitted to it.
