

**ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02-005**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION FOR MAY 11, 2013, TO ELECT A MAYOR AND THREE COUNCIL MEMBERS; DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES; APPOINTING THE EARLY VOTING CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE AND PUBLICATION OF THE ELECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City Charter of the City of McKinney, Texas as adopted on December 31, 1959, and amended on November 8, 1971, January 15, 1977, May 7, 1988, May 5, 2001, and December 6, 2011 requires that an election for Mayor, Council member At-Large, Council member for District 1, and Council member for District 3 be held; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Charter requires the Mayor and three Council members be elected for four (4) year terms, the Council member from District 1 and District 3 to be elected from the single-member Council Districts in which they reside by resident voters of those districts, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS:**

- Section 1. That a general election is hereby ordered to be held on Saturday, May 11, 2013, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, and Chapter III of the City Charter of McKinney, Texas as amended.
- Section 2. That an election be held for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Council member At-Large, a Council member for District 1, and a Council member for District 3 for four-year terms as prescribed by the City Charter.
- Section 3. That candidates for the Council member positions may file for one of the four (4) positions beginning on January 30, 2013 and until 5:00 p.m. on March 1, 2013.
- Section 4. That the McKinney Performing Arts Center, 111 N. Tennessee, Collin County Community College Central Park Campus, 2200 West University Drive (U. S. Highway 380), Collin County Elections Office, 2010 Redbud Boulevard, Suite 102, Fire Station #5, 6600 W. Virginia Parkway are hereby designated as early voting polling places for said election. City and School District voters may vote at any of the additional Early Voting locations open under full contract services with the Collin County Elections Administration.
- Section 5. That the City Hall, 222 N. Tennessee, Collin County Community College Central Park Campus, 2200 West University Drive (U. S. Highway 380), Reuben Johnson Elementary School, 3400 Ash Lane, Earl H. Slaughter Elementary School, 2706 Wolford Avenue, McKinney Boyd High School, 600 North Lake Forest Drive, and C.T. Eddins Elementary School, 311 Peregrin Drive are hereby designated as election day polling places for stated County Precincts for said election.
- Section 6. That the method of voting to be used in the general election on Saturday, May 11, 2013, be touch-screen devices with Premier Election Systems ACCUVOTE TS R7 v.4.6.4 direct recording

devices (DRE's) for early voting and election day and optical-scan ballots with Premier Election Systems ACCUVOTE OS ROM v.2.0.12 for early voting by mail.

Section 7. That the Collin County Elections Administrator is hereby appointed Alternate Early Voting Clerk for the purpose of conducting early voting for the general election.

Section 8. All applications for an Early Voting mail ballot shall be received and processed by the Collin County Elections Administration Office, 2010 Redbud Blvd., Suite 102. McKinney, Texas 75069

Section 9. That early voting by personal appearance be conducted beginning on Monday, April 29, 2013, and shall close on Tuesday, May 7, 2013. During the lawful early voting by personal appearance period (April 29, 2013, through May 7, 2013), Collin County Elections Administrator shall keep the designated early voting polling places open for early voting as follows:

Monday, April 29	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Tuesday, April 30	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Wednesday, May 1	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Thursday, May 2	8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Friday, May 3	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Saturday, May 4	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Monday, May 6	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Tuesday, May 7	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 10. That the official canvass, by the City Council, will be held in accordance with Election Code 67.003(a) between the eighth and eleventh day after election day.

Section 11. That a Notice of Election shall be published at least one (1) time, not more than thirty (30) days nor less than ten (10) days before the election in the McKinney Courier Gazette.

Section 12. That the Notice of Election be posted in accordance with the State Law, including a posting on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council at least twenty-one (21) days before election day.

Section 13. That a copy of this Ordinance be delivered to the Collin County Clerk and Voter Registrar not later than the 60<sup>th</sup> day before election day.

Section 14. That this Ordinance and all other related documents be printed in both English and Spanish in accordance with all legal requirements.
