ORDINANCE NO. 2016-10-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, BY AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH (c) OF SECTION 26-50, "CREATION," TO ALIGN THE TERM LENGTH OF ANIMAL SERVICE FACILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS TO CONFORM TO THE CITY OF MCKINNEY POLICY ON BOARD AND COMMISSION MEMBER APPOINTMENT AND ELIGIBILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- WHEREAS, on September 20, 2016, the City Council of McKinney, Texas ("City Council") amended the City of McKinney Policy on Board and Commission Member Appointment and Eligibility ("Policy"); and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council's amendments to the Policy included establishing a oneyear term of office for most of the City's board and commission members; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the term of office for members of the Animal Service Facility Advisory Committee to be consistent with the Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. All of the above premises are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, Chapter 26, "Animal Control," Article IX, "Animal Service Facility Advisory Committee," Section 26-50, "Creation," by deleting subparagraph (c) in its entirety and replacing said subparagraph with a new subparagraph (c) to read as follows:
 - "(c) The committee shall consist of at least four (4) members appointed by a majority vote of the City Council. Committee members shall serve for the term of office provided for in the City of McKinney Policy on Board and Commission Member Appointment and Eligibility."
- Section 3. All ordinances, orders, or resolutions heretofore adopted by the City Council are hereby repealed to the extent that said ordinances, orders, or resolutions, or parts thereof, conflict with this Ordinance.
- Section 4. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any valid portion of this or any other Ordinance of the City.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after the date of its final passage.
