We again oppose rezoning item as posted above. Reasons are in duplicate to previous zoning request to install a telecommunications tower at Furr Elementary School, at Bluestem and Hidden Haven in McKinney.

We understand the current request is to install the tower on property that was originally zoned for a city park!

Please provide clarification prior to public hearing regarding the status of the city park, should rezoning of the cell tower installation be approved!

As adjacent homeowners, we continue to experience extreme stress surrounding this whole rezoning issue. Nothing is coherent to what was disclosed when we originally purchased our property! We were assured the property adjacent to the school and our property would be green space or a city park! How do you plan a city park around an 85 foot cell tower?? The property behind our home has taken on a life of its own and we feel helpless to have any influence. Please help to give credence the neighborhood impact and not just what the telecommunications company sees as a revenue stream! This is a poorly chosen site for the telecommunications tower which was not a part of the original community plan. As a neighborhood we are not destitute! The majority of homeowners have easy access to communication via Wi-Fi calling and internet. This is not the dire situation that Verizon implies!
