- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves the acceptance and implementation of the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant award through the Office of the Governor (OOG) to upgrade the City of McKinney Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to a digital platform.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
