What is a Comprehensive Plan?

What

- A Comprehensive Plan is a statement of the community's vision now and for the future.
- Typically comprised of a number of interrelated elements such as land use, transportation, utilities, public services, socioeconomic, preservation, and open space elements.

Why

- Provides direction for the City's future growth and development
- Sets goals for many aspects of civic operations



How is a Comprehensive Plan Used?

- Used to coordinate and guide the establishment of development regulations.
- Used to provide a basis for future zoning decisions.
- Helps to guide public investments in transportation and other infrastructure improvements that aide in guiding future development.



2004 Future Land Use Plan





DRAFT Preferred Scenario




DRAFT Thoroughfare Plan (Aug. 2016)


