Keith provided a status update on the project that included a review of Scope, Budget

and Timing/Timeline for the project:

Scope - no significant changes to report.

Budget - SpawGlass is close to 100% buyout. Based on variances with respect to

savings in some areas and overage in others - project is within budget but will likely use all

funds allocated.

Timing – prefabricated metal building for the brewery will be delivered between July 18

and August. Timing is impacted by concrete pour for the fire lanes. GST is working with the

TUPPS team to address questions regarding their work in the Tap Room. Work on the area

that will be used as an outdoor event venue on the east side of the campus may be phased

in after primary project components are complete. Updated completion date is mid-to-late

November.

B.Y.O.B. program - 76 submittals were received following announcement of the

program. TUPPS team will perform initial review, followed by review by TUPPS, MCDC

subcommittee and MEDC reviewer to identify program participants. Completion of the

process is expected by mid-August.

The August subcommittee will be at the construction site on August 16 at 8:30 a.m.
