WHEREAS, Chief Cook was critically injured and still responded as the trained Firefighter to provide first aid on himself and render lifesaving first aid on the second victim; and

WHEREAS, Chief Cook exemplifies the sacrifices that our fire personnel provide each and every day in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney wishes to acknowledge the heroic actions of Chief Cook which resulted in the saving of two lives.
