Final Report Narrative for McKinney Repertory Theatre 2015-2016 Season

McKinney Repertory Theatre recently completed our 13th season. We kicked of the season with the World Premier of 'Belles: The Reunion' by Mark Dunn. Mark wrote 'Belles' in 1988, a play consisting of many phone calls between six sisters spread across the country discussing events in their lives. McKinney Rep has produced 'Belles' twice, it was our first production in 2012, and produced another play of Mark's, 'Five Tellers Dancing In The Rain' and both were well received by our audiences. Mark contacted MRT and asked us if we would be willing to produce the World Premier of 'Belles: The Reunion', a play about the six sisters 25 years after the events of 'Belles' and we readily agreed. Mark and his wife attended the opening weekend performance on October 9th, driving to McKinney from their home in Santa Fe. We did a lot of promotion advertising the play and to our surprise and disappointment it was poorly attended. We did six performances, on October 9, 10, 11, 16, 17, and total attendance was 112.

In November and December we performed our annual production of 'A Christmas Carol', adaption by McKinney resident Dr. Andrew Harris. Our most well attended production every year, we had 1196 attend 8 performances. Performance dates were November 27, 28, (two performances each day), 29, December 18, 19. We also did a reading of 'A Christmas Carol' at the Collin County Juvenile Detention Center on December 15th with about 60 staff and juveniles in attendance.

'A Reunion of Sorts', the winner of 2015 New Play Competition, was performed in March. It was written by Jerry Lacy specifically for older actors. Jerry is a very respected actor who has appeared in several television series, movies, and Broadway plays. The two main characters in the play are retired Army buddies, now in their seventies. Two actors in their seventies were cast, one of them has performed in MRT shows in smaller roles. The other was a relatively inexperienced actor. After two weeks of rehearsals one of the actors dropped because he felt there were just too many lines to memorize and was replaced by Jake Correll. The other actor was also struggling with lines and after four weeks of rehearsal also dropped. The director took over his role but two weeks was not sufficient time to memorize all the lines. Jerry and his wife, Julia Duffy, an actress best known for her role as Stephanie on 'The Bob Newhart Show' were planning on coming to McKinney opening weekend, scheduled for March 11th. Jerry was contacted and informed that we were cancelling the opening weekend. We only did three performances, on March 18th and 19th; Jerry and Julia attended the evening performance on the 18th and matinee on the 19th. Total attendance for the three performances was 200.

Our fourth show of the season was 'Sordid Lives' by Del Shores with five performances on May 13, 14, 21, 22. Total attendance was 297.

Our final show of the season was our annual melodrama. This year's production was 'Bad Medicine (Or Good To The Last Drop) by Houston playwright Kris Thompson, with six performances on August 5, 6, 7, 13, 14. Kris drove up from Houston and attended the August 7th matinee. Total attendance was 415.
