ORDINANCE NO. 97-04-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1270 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS; SO THAT A 37.296 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF U.S. HIGHWAY 75, WEST OF REDBUD BOULEVARD, SOUTH OF BLOOMDALE ROAD, AND APPROXIMATELY 1,500 FEET NORTH OF WILMETH ROAD IS ZONED FROM "AG" - AGRICULTURE DISTRICT TO "C" PLANNED CENTER DISTRICT; PROVIDING REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF; PROVIDING FOR NO VESTED INTEREST; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

- WHEREAS, having been petitioned by the owner of a tract of land located on the east side of U.S.. Highway 75, approximately 3,000 feet north of Wilmeth Road, in the City of McKinney, Collin County, Texas, for a rezoning of said tract to a "C" Planned Center District, the City of McKinney has expanded the consideration of rezoning to a "C" Planned Center District to adjacent properties, for a total area of 37.296 acres, located on the east side of U.S. Highway 75, west of Redbud Boulevard, south of Bloomdale Road, and approximately 1,500 feet north of Bloomdale Road, a complete legal description of such area being attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof for all purposes; and,
- WHEREAS, after due notice of the proposed zoning as required by law, and the required public hearings held before the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, the City Council is of the opinion that said rezoning should be made.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- SECTION 1. The subject tract of land, located on the east side of U.S. Highway 75, west of Redbud Boulevard, south of Bloomdale Road, and approximately 1,500 feet north of Wilmeth Road, in the City of McKinney, Collin County, Texas, which is more fully described on Exhibit "A" and depicted on Exhibit "B" attached hereto, is hereby rezoned from "AG" Agriculture District to "C" Planned Center District.
- SECTION 2. The property herein rezoned shall be developed according to the regulations of Section 3.14 of Ordinance 1270, and all other regulations applicable to development within the "C" Planned Center District, as amended from time to time.
- SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or clause of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
- SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to develop this property, or any portion thereof, in any manner other than is authorized by this Ordinance, and upon conviction therefore, shall be fined any sum not exceeding \$200.00, and each day that such violation shall continue shall be considered a separate offense. These penal provisions shall not prevent an action on behalf of the City of McKinney to enjoin any violation or threatened violation of the terms of this Ordinance, or an action for mandatory injunction to remove any previous violation hereof.
- SECTION 5. The no developer or property owner shall acquire any vested interest in this Ordinance, the Planned Development, or specific regulations contained herein.

The ordinance and regulations may be amended or repealed by the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. The caption of this Ordinance shall be published one time in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of McKinney, and shall become effective upon such publication.
