Dear McKinney Arts Commissioners,

We would first like to thank the McKinney Arts Commission for their continued support of Chamberlain Performing Arts. As our season comes to a close we remain grateful to have such excellent support to fulfill our mission within the McKinney community and beyond. Per your request, below you will find a detailed project report for the program that was funded through the McKinney Arts Commission.

Releve After-School Dance Program:

In partnership with the Boys and Girls Clubs of Collin County, the Relevé After-School dance program provides free, weekly dance classes during the school year as well as a week-long workshop in the summer to students ages 6-12 at the McKinney Boys and Girls Club. This season we reached 58 students with these free dance classes and are excited to announce a 66% increase in attendance during the school year from the previous season. Approximately 86% of the students we serve are of minority ethnic groups (African-American, Hispanic, and multi-racial) and are considered of low income families. We believe that everyone should have access to professional quality dance and dance instruction; therefore, it is our mission to serve our community members who otherwise would not have these opportunities.

It is proven that children who engage in the arts at an early age show increased confidence, critical thinking, and the ability to challenge themselves. The Relevé program promotes discipline, focus, hard work, and increased self-esteem through the skills they learn within the weekly dance classes. Through the Releve program the students are exposed to a variety of dance forms including: creative movement, ballet, and jazz. The program concludes with an end-of year performance that exposes them to a real-world theater experience at the Eisemann Center in Richardson, TX. The students are provided costumes and makeup, the families are provided a pair of complimentary tickets to the performance, and everyone is invited to join together and celebrate at the cast party following the performance.




