Junior Players' McKinney Arts Commission Narrative Final Report 2016/2017

In 2016/17 Junior Players continued its program offerings in McKinney by providing 39 after-school sessions at Old Settler's and 10 sessions at McKinney Community Center. One Discover Art program was offered for 10 sessions at McKinney Community Center, one Discover Art program was offered for 20 sessions at Old Settler's Recreation Center and one Discover Dance program was offered for 19 sessions at Old Settler's Recreation Center. Attendance in all workshops was great and the objectives of each workshop were successfully met. In 2017, we also continued our Discover Theater program for 22 sessions at Dr. Jack Cockrill Middle School. Attendance was full and students were on the waiting list. The objectives of this middle school program were successfully met.

In the summer of 2017, Junior Players provided 4 Discover Theater camps in McKinney at McKinney Community Center, Old Settler's Recreation Center and the McKinney Performing Arts Center, 1 in June, 2 in July and 1 in August. These camps are designed to introduce children to basic skills in theater utilizing various theater games and oral communication exercises. The students also put together an original short play that was performed at the summer camps' culminating event called The Festival of Plays. Overall, the children had a very positive experience, and the teaching objectives were successfully met. Also in the summer of 2017, we held an Advanced Discover Shakespeare workshop at the McKinney Performing Arts Center in June/July.

In Participant Surveys, 82% said they felt more confident speaking in front of others, 74% want to learn more about the arts, 71% reported feeling better about themselves as a result of the program, and 83% want to do more theater. According to parents of McKinney participants 79% noticed an increase in their child's self-esteem, 79% noticed that their child was more confident speaking in front of others and 100% would recommend our program to a friend.

When asked what students liked most about our classes and camps, participant comments included:

- "I enjoyed how each activity as creative and does its best to include everyone." Tristan, Age 12, Old Settler's Recreation Center
- "I liked the teachers and the time structuring and the balance of work and fun. I felt that the camp was educational and productive and fun." Andrew Mao, Age 14, McKinney Performing Arts Center
- "I liked that we got to learn about stuff we've never learned about before." Rylee, Age 11, McKinney Community Center
- "This was fun and I want to do it again." Addy, Age 9, Old Settler's Recreation Center
- "I like the dances." Jazlin, Age 7, Old Settler's Recreation Center
