

WHEREAS,	the city of McKinney, Texas is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting McKinney; and	
WHEREAS,	U.S. fire departments responded to 371,500 home fires in 2016, according the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA); and	
WHEREAS,	U.S. home fires resulted in 2,735 civilian deaths in 2016, representing the majority (71 percent) of all U.S. fire deaths; and	
WHEREAS,	newer homes are built with lightweight material that burn faster than older home constructions; and	
WHEREAS,	many of today's products and furnishings produce toxic gases and smoke when burned, making it impossible to see and breathe within moments; and	
WHEREAS,	these conditions contribute to a much smaller window of time for people to escape a home fire safely, with people having as little as one to two minutes to escape from the time the smoke alarm sounds; and	
WHEREAS,	a home fire escape plan provides the skill set and know-how to quickly and safely escape a home fire situation; and	
WHEREAS,	a home fire escape plan includes two exits from every room in the home; a path to the outside from each exit; smoke alarms in all required locations; and a meeting place outside where everyone in the home will meet upon exiting; and	
WHEREAS,	home fire escape plans should be developed by all members of the household; and	
WHEREAS,	practicing a home fire escape plan twice a year ensures that everyone in the household knows what to do in a real fire situation; and	
WHEREAS,	McKinney's first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and	
WHEREAS,	McKinney's residents are responsive to public education measures and are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes; and	
WHEREAS,	the 2017 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!" effectively serves to educate the public about the vital importance of developing a home fire escape with all members of the household and practicing it twice a year.
