


Proposed Regulations

- The proposed Ordinance will align with the MISD and Collin College election guidelines.
- Electioneering on City owned property is limited only to the City owned or controlled public property where the voting is conducted and only during the voting periods.
- Electioneering on City owned or controlled property will be limited to the Designated Area for Electioneering.































- Electioneering on private property is allowed with the permission of the property owner.
- The regulations will only apply to City owned or controlled locations:
 - Right of Ways
 - Polling locations (John and Judy Gay Library, Senior Center, Old Settlers Recreation Center, MPAC, City Hall, Fire Station #5, Fire Station #7, and future Fire Station #9).
- Establishes a posting period for election signs (24 hours before the election and removed within 24 hours after the end of a voting period).



Proposed Regulations contd.

- Signs will be limited to four 2' x 2' signs per candidate or measure at each of the City owned or controlled polling locations.
- Tents, awnings or shelters are not permitted.
- Each location will have a Designated Area for Electioneering where electioneering can take place.
- Electioneering is prohibited on any City owned or controlled property that is not used for a polling location.



Proposed Regulations contd.

- All signs placed in violation of this Ordinance will be removed and disposed of by City Staff.
- The Ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the City Secretary, a designated election officer, code enforcement official, or law enforcement official.
