

Election Sign Posting Guidelines

McKinney ISD has established guidelines related to the posting of signs on McKinney ISD property during elections. The following information is provided for candidates who desire to post signs or have a presence on campuses during election periods. Signs shall only be permitted on campuses serving as a polling location.

- Signs shall be defined as a billboard, yard sign, notice, poster, banner or any hand-held sign.
- Election signs shall be limited to **two signs per candidate** at each McKinney ISD polling site, at a location designated by McKinney ISD during early voting and on Election Day when the campus is a voting site. Such signs are limited to sizes not to exceed 4' x 4' and must be either hand-held or staked into the ground. T-posts are not allowed.
- Tents, awnings or shelters are not permitted on McKinney ISD property.
- Megaphones are not permitted on McKinney ISD property.
- All electioneering must comply with applicable election laws.
- Authorized areas for signs will be designated in advance (refer to maps).
- Campaign signs may be posted 24 hours prior to the election day.
- All campaign signs must be removed from McKinney ISD property within 24-hours after an election is over.

Slaughter Elementary will be open as a polling location from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, May 6, 2017, for voting in a general election. The yellow area designated on the map above indicates the area approved for posting election signs at Slaughter. Signs may be posted 24 hours prior to election day and must be removed no later than 24 hours after the election.
