- 9 resident companies with 24 employees
- Monthly revenue of approximately \$2900
- Monthly expenses of approximately \$5200, excluding staff

Traditional Coworking Provides Space

They rent space by the foot and try to sell it by the seat. Focused on optimizing number in the space, not on building the companies, or helping the entrepreneurs grow. This is a Real Estate Play, not an Economic Development Play.







- Help launch, manage, and grow an entrepreneur center based on our proven COWORKING model
- Create and host events, education, and programs that serve entrepreneurs
- Marketing for driving memberships and partnerships to the location
- Provide the environment and amenities conducive for startups
- Access to our playbook, training, and consultation on how to build and grow an entrepreneur center











What The DEC Does for The WERX



- WECAN Playbook (Worldwide Entrepreneur Center Affiliate Network)
- Includes ongoing support, updates, maintenance
- Monthly calls with entire WECAN network.
- \$60,000 per year of support through programming, administrative support, management, events, educational training, mentorship development, media promotion and marketing/social media support













DEC Benefits for Members

This includes all of the perks and benefits of being a DEC member and includes things like:

- Opportunity to apply for free flights on American Airlines
- Up to \$60,000 per employee of free Microsoft technology
- 90% discount on a Hub Spot Membership
- Discounts at Dell
- Discounts on cloud computing and hosting
- \$120k the first year through SoftLayer
- \$5-\$10k per month of free credits through Amazon (AWS)
- The list of benefits is continually growing. As the benefits grow, DEC Affiliates will receive access to all of these benefits for their community as well.













- A space, at no cost, to operate The WERX


