I am writing regarding the status of your campaign treasurer appointment. Pursuant to the Texas Election Code, campaign treasurer appointments continue until terminated by the candidate, political committee, or the City. Moreover, City records indicate you have never filed or have ceased to file reports pursuant to chapter 254 of the Texas Election Code, and are considered an inactive candidate or inactive political committee. Further, in the case of a candidate, who was not elected to City office, City records indicate the candidate has not filed a final report, or dissolution report pursuant to the Texas Election Code.

Consequently, this letter serves as notice that the City Council will consider the proposed termination of the candidate's or committee's campaign treasurer appointment at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting to be held on:
