A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, REJECT, ALTER OR TERMINATE, A GRANT TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE STATE OF TEXAS, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, FOR A VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT, TO CONTINUE TO FUND A VICTIM ADVOCATE

- **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need to maintain the level of services provided to victims of crime within the City of McKinney, through the ongoing funding of a Victim's Advocate for FY19-20; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant will be used by the City of McKinney Police Department to continue to fund the Victim Advocate position; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds as required by the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, in full; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the City Manager as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the agreement on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves ratification of the application, acceptance and implementation of the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant award, through the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, to be used by the City of McKinney Police Department to continue to fund a Victim Advocate position.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
