THIRTEENTH ANNUAL CRAPE MYRTLE RUN AND FESTIVAL

CMT Board has donated hundreds of thousands dollars to MISD and area schools.

McKinney, Texas: Saturday morning, September 29, 2018 is the annual Crape Myrtle Run 10K, 5K, 1-Mile Fun Run and Free Family Festival featuring very fast USATF-certified courses. The start/finish line for all walkers and runners is located this year at McKinney Boyd High School, 600 North Lake Forest Drive, McKinney, Texas 75070. Races begin at 8:00 and 8:30 a.m. with check-in and free family festival at 7:00 a.m.

Phil Wheat, president of the <u>Crape Myrtle Trails Board</u> said, "Once again, our run begins Saturday morning and offers a fun family event with healthy options while allowing participants to burn off a few calories before heading downtown to enjoy the remainder of <u>McKinney Oktoberfest</u> weekend. It's a great family-fun event, but it's for serious runners too. We hope folks from all over Texas, Oklahoma, and Arkansas will come to "Run, Shop, and Stay" and see what a great place McKinney is."

The free festival area of this annual event includes activities in "Myrtle Village" before, during, and after the races. Entertainment and activities include a petting zoo, face painting, photo booth, bounce house, inflatable obstacle course, music, warm-up exercises - and a great favorite, the Chicken Dance. In a long-established tradition, students from area schools with the largest registered run participation will get to see their coach or principal Kiss a Pig. ("Myrtle" is the pig's name.)

Rodney Haynes, CMT Board member and this year's Run Chair, commented, "This year's run course is terrific and is USATF-certified and timed. We hired a new timing company this year – Matt Compton with Compton Time and Measure. And there will be trophies, medals, and prizes galore. We're giving prizes away for the best dressed runners, best pig costume, and best media post too."

Take advantage of the early-bird discount rate before September 24, 2018 at Get Me Registered. The last day for runner's packet pickup at Run-On in McKinney is Thursday, September 27, 2018. After Thursday, September 27, all registrations and packet pickup will be onsite on race day at 7:00 a.m. For onsite registrations on Saturday morning, runners can "skip the line" by using their mobile device for registration. There will be large QR codes within the registration area for runners as a way to speed race day registrations.

Medals and trophies will be awarded in multiple age divisions. In addition, area schools reap benefits when Crape Myrtle Trails Board members return a portion of the profits from this race, based on runners' registrations, to any schools with registered runners. Since its incorporation date in 1998, The Crape Myrtle Trails of McKinney Foundation has donated hundreds of thousands dollars to MISD and area schools.


