- Bike the Bricks founded 2009
- Friday Memorial Weekend, 10hr event
- 500 cyclists, largest cycling race in Texas
- Course travels through HDM





- Set-up & activities restrict access to HDM
- Increasing frustration from merchants
- Surveys document concerns/criticism
- Impacts vary:
 - Some restaurants high sales
 - Some retailers close day of event



- BTB is funded through MMS (501c3)
- Revenues: Registration, Sponsorships, Concession Sales
- Expenses: Payout, Event Infrastructure
- BTB = Net Loss \$18k to MMS
- BTB = \$33k expense in City Services



- September 2018 presentation to Council to share HDM feedback
- Council Directive:

"Explore other route options within Downtown Area"




Other Route Options:

- MMS met with cycling organizers looked at several possibilities
- Try to meet race criteria:
 - Course length
 - Elevation
 - Road conditions
- Try to meet festival criteria:
 - Gathering space
 - Activity area



Residential Route



Residential Route:

- September direction from Council
- October route identified
- November route distributed to MHNA
 - Received very limited feedback
- February meeting with residents
 - Negative feedback issued survey




Resident Survey:

- Approx 60 homes with direct impact
- Survey response from 26 homes (22 directly on route)
- 12 Negative/Moderate Negative Impact
- 14 No Impact or Positive Impact

- Limited business impact
- Direct impact 27 residents
- Increased infrastructure costs with Finch Park
