A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY AND ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET ASIDE PROGRAM PROJECT

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need for and benefits of providing a community park in the City of McKinney; and
- WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Council will award funding on June 13, 2019 for active transportation projects through the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Call for Projects; and
- The City of McKinney intends to submit a transportation alternatives project **WHEREAS** application for the Wilson Creek Greens Trail connection to the North Central Texas Council of Governments prior to the March 01, 2019 deadline; and
- WHEREAS, the Parks Master Plan and the Comprehensive Plan have identified the Wilson Creek corridor as an area to preserve and use as parkland; and
- WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Council requires the submittal of a resolution as part of the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Call for Projects application submission; and
- WHEREAS, the matching funds for this funding assistance program application are identified in the Capital Improvement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the City Section 1. Manager, or designee, to apply for the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Call for Projects application.
- The City of McKinney commits to fund a minimum local cash match of Section 2. \$1,000,000 of the total project cost.
- Section 4. The City of McKinney confirms that McKinney, not the Regional Transportation Council, will be responsible for any cost overruns.
- Section 5. The City of McKinney understands and acknowledges that all awarded funding is provided on a reimbursement basis.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
