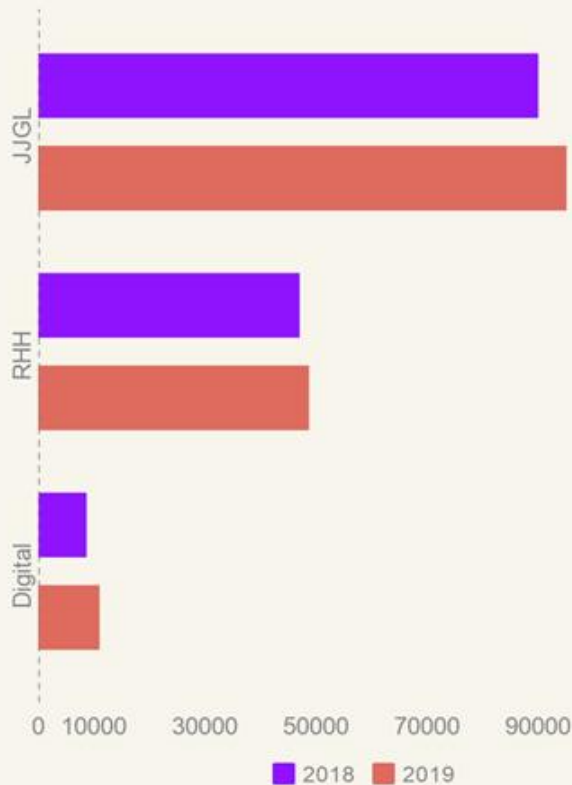


Our early planning for potential construction woes has really paid off by allowing us to work with the great people at Fire Station 7. They have been a joy to work with and the kids seem to like it too!

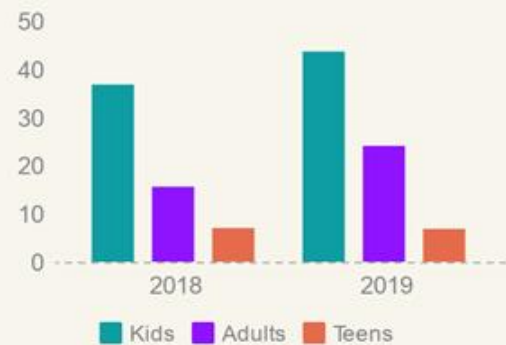


The Numbers
