# Annual Paid Leave <u>Hours</u> Accrued (Five Years of Service)



#### **Conclusions**

- McKinney is above average in comparison of our benchmark cities in regards to paid time off.
- Over the past three years, employees are taking over 5 weeks of paid leave for time off specifically for birth or adoption of a child.
- These employees are still left with over 13 weeks of paid leave in their leave banks to be used for paid time off.
- In general, employees are provided with adequate leave benefits through vacation and sick benefits to continue to have paid time off for family needs.
