Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. The NCS captures residents' opinions within the three pillars of a community (Community Characteristics, Governance and Participation) across eight central facets of community (Safety, Mobility, Natural Environment, Built Environment, Economy, Recreation and Wellness, Education and Enrichment and Community Engagement). This report discusses trends over time, comparing the 2019 ratings for the City of McKinney to its previous survey results in 2017. Additional reports and technical appendices are available under separate cover.

Trend data for McKinney represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines. Deviations from stable trends over time, especially, represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs or public information may have affected residents' opinions.

Meaningful differences between survey years have been noted within the following tables as being "higher" or "lower" if the differences are greater than five percentage points between the 2017 and 2019 surveys, otherwise the comparisons between 2017 and 2019 are noted as being "similar." Additionally, benchmark comparisons for all survey years are presented for reference. Changes in the benchmark comparison over time can be impacted by various trends, including varying survey cycles for the individual communities that comprise the benchmarks, regional and national economic or other events, as well as emerging survey methodologies.

Overall, ratings in McKinney remained stable across the years. Of the 131 items for which comparisons were available, 119 items were rated similarly in 2017 and 2019, three items showed a decrease in ratings and nine showed an increase in ratings. The few changes were seen in these areas:

- Residents' ratings for the following increased from 2017 to 2019: overall built environment, public places, shopping opportunities, cultural/arts/music activities, recreation centers and the respondent's assessment of their personal health. Other aspects that improved over time were the City welcoming citizen involvement, the City's customer service and services provided by McKinney.
- Decreases in ratings were only seen for three items: crime prevention, traffic enforcement and the economy having a positive impact on the respondent's income.
