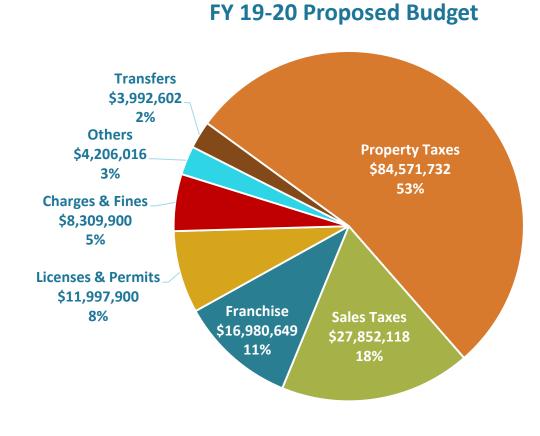

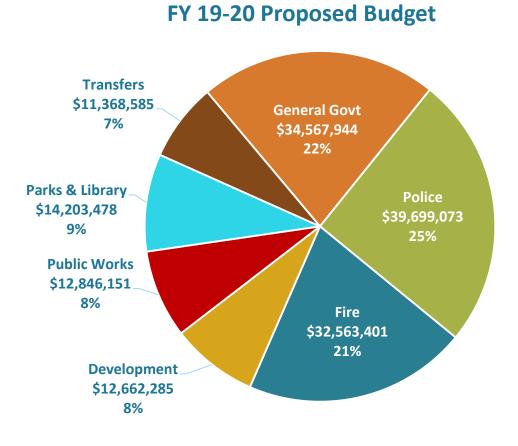


### General Fund Revenues - \$157,910,917

# Water/Wastewater Fund



#### Water and Wastewater Highlights

- FY20 Revenue Budget \$101,977,774
- FY20 Expenditure Budget \$101,238,041
- Continue water line replacement program
- Anticipate a debt sale for capital projects in FY20
  Use some operating fund reserve to offset debt need
- Supplementals proposed include:
  - Sewer Maintenance Repair Crew
  - Fire Hydrant & Valve Service Personnel (3)
  - Redbud Pump Station Operating Costs
  - Pump Operator



#### Water and Wastewater Rates

- Rates and NTMWD
  - NTMWD FY20
    - 8% Increase on Water & Wastewater
    - Increased rates due to capital improvements district wide & increased regulatory requirements
  - City of McKinney proposes
    - 2% increase on Water
    - 6% increase on Wastewater
    - Two volumetric rate tiers added (1-7k gals and 60k+)
    - Allows for Water/Wastewater fund to remain self-sufficient
