

What is TIFMAS?


- SEC. 418.111 CREATION OF THE TEXAS STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID SYSTEM
 - Established in the 2007 Legislative Session
 - Provide integrated statewide mutual aid response
 - Is intended to provide support to any jurisdiction that needs it after local/regional resources have been exhausted

- 431 Departments State-wide






2017 Hurricane Harvey

- 11 Days
- Hazmat protection
- Rescue




2018 Panhandle Fires

- 8 Days
- 74,000 acres burned
- 300 Firefighters assigned




2018 McDannald Ranch Fire

- 10 Days
- 19,000 acres burned



2018 Scenic Loop Complex

- 7 Days
- 20,000 acres burned
- 190 firefighters assigned



2018 Woolsey Fire (California)

- 10 Days
- 97,000 acres burned
- 1600 structures destroyed
- 200 firefighters from Texas



2019 Vivian Fire


- Wildland Paramedic Unit
- 2nd WPU in state history
- 12,000 acres burned





Cost

- All cost incurred by the strike team are reimbursed
 - Salaries
 - Food
 - Lodging
 - Back-fill salaries
 - Pays for personnel to fill in at home unit while members are deployed






Type III Engine
