2018 – 2019 Young Actors Guild McKinney Arts Commission Final Report

The Young Actors Guild's 2018- 2019 season consisted of 22 workshops and 5 productions for our membership of 65 students. We held a total of 44 hours of workshops, rehearsed approximately 315 hours and staged 5 productions that were performed at the Courthouse Theater in the McKinney Performing Arts Center. In total, we produced 17 performances open to everyone in McKinney, TX and beyond.

Our drama, *Paper Dragons* written by local playwright, Roberta Elliott was staged with a cast and crew of 31. It was performed at the MPAC 4 times for an audience totaling 166 attendants on October 26, 27, 28, 2018.

Our Romantic Comedy, was brought to stage as 2 one acts, held on February 1, 2 and 3, 2019 at the MPAC. 8 Ways to Prevent the First Date from Going Completely and Horribly Wrong, written by YAG student, Christina Sexton and The 9 Worst Breakups of All Time, written by Ian McWethy; had a youth cast and crew of 30 members that performed to a total audience of 195 attendants.

This season's annual Shakespeare production was *Antony and Cleopatra*, written by William Shakespeare. We had a cast and crew of 24 youth members and performed 4 times at The MPAC on March 21, 22 & 23, 2019 for an audience total of 139.

On June 14th we traveled to Irving, TX to participate in Texas Nonprofit Youth Conference. We brought 4 chaperones and 17 youth members which included cast, crew and director, to attend workshops and perform *Again Tomorrow* written and directed by a YAG student. No funds from the MAC Grant are spent on this annual activity. This year, each participant was required to pay \$375, and money raised through fundraisers was used to help cover the expenses incurred from the trip. This is the 9th year YAG has represented the City of McKinney at this conference, and the Young Actors Guild returned home proudly with several recognitions of excellence.

Prior to our departure, the Young Actors Guild rehearsed in McKinney at the MPAC and performed a one night only stage performance on May 28th at MPAC's Courthouse Theater in a free showing open to the public, and 60 people were in attendance. We took advantage of this production to promote our company and fundraise.

In July we completed the season with our Fairytale *King Arthur and the Shoppes at Camelot*, cowritten and directed by YAG student Kenneth McCalpin and his mother Julie McCalpin. This production had a youth cast and crew of 27. We held 4 performances at the MPAC on July 11, 12 & 13th, 2019, with a total attendance of 156.
