

Final Report Narrative for McKinney Repertory Theatre 2018-2019 Season

McKinney Repertory Theatre recently completed its 16th season. Our first show of the season was to have been *Angel Street* by Patrick Hamilton. It is the story of a woman who is being 'gaslighted' by her husband. It was to have benefitted Hope Rising with donations of goods at performances. There was also going to be a question and answer session to help anyone seeking help for themselves or someone they knew. Unfortunately, one of the leads came down with pneumonia the Sunday before opening and was hospitalized. We were forced to cancel the show so we had no income from it but we did have expenses. It was to have run from October 5 through October 13 for a total of six performances.

In November and December we performed our annual production of *A Christmas Carol*, an adaption by McKinney resident Dr. Andrew Harris. An annual Holiday favorite, total attendance for the nine performances was 1413 with 20 comp tickets. Performances were November 23 - 25, and, during McKinney's Home For The Holidays, December 14 and 15. For the fifth year, we also did a staged reading at the Collin County Juvenile Detention Center. This year residents of the Center again participated in the reading.

Our third show of the season was Jeffrey Lane's *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels*, a musical based on the movie of the same name. In it, two conmentry to swindle an attractive woman out of her fortune, little knowing she was a con woman scheming to take the men for all they were worth. Attendance was 727 with 74 comps. There were six performances on February 22, 23, 24, and March 1 and 2.

Our next production was *The Mousetrap* by Agatha Christie. This is the longest continually running show in theater history and has thrilled audiences all over the world. We had a very successful run of this mystery and attendance was 502 with 36 comps. We had six performances May 10, 11, 12, 17, and 18.

Our last production of the season was our annual melodrama, a popcorn throwing, audience participation show. This year's production was *The Man in the Locket* by Texas playwright Kris Thompson. The show revolves around a young woman who is trying to find a father who left her many years before. She runs away from the people who have been 'caring' for her for many years when she finds they want to marry her off to someone she does not love. She winds up in a circus where we meet many unusual characters and the hilarity ensues. There were nine performances on August 2 - 17. Total attendance was 752 with 72 comps.

With only 4 productions, we still had a total of 3,394 patrons with 202 comps issued.
