


ZONE FUNDS

- Developer fees (1 acre of land for every 50-residential units – or the cash equivalent)
- Money collected in a zone can only be spent in the same zone

MCDC

- P & R requests a \$ 5.5 M MCDC grant each year
- MCDC grant money can be spent anywhere in any zone




- Gabion walls are rectangular baskets made of steel wire or heaxagonal wire mesh, filled with stone and tied tagether to form a wall.








- Each year, Umbrella Funding is utilized to fill budget gaps for individual projects, as well as fund special projects






OUTCOMES

- 11 neighborhood parks built between 1994 and 2004 will be renovated
 We can better pace future renovations: 1 2 per year
- Cost savings by packaging the parks together for design/construction
- 9 / 10 "critical needs" parks (2017 Parks Master Plan) will be addressed
 Towne Lake TBD
- Every park East of Highway 5 will be renovated
- Except for Towne Lake, Mitchell & Central Parks, every park east of Highway 75 will be renovated
- We are putting over \$1.2 of MCDC grant money to work across the City
 Pushes the \$8.5 M MCDC balance down another \$1.2 M
