



Final Project Report BLUEGRASS SATURDAY NIGHT

McKinney Performing Arts Center, McKinney, Texas

The Bluegrass Heritage Foundation was pleased to present its **Bluegrass Saturday Night** bluegrass music event, funded in part by the McKinney Arts Commission, on Saturday night, November 16, 2019 at the McKinney Performing Arts Center ("MPAC").

A detailed financial report showing the actual and budgeted revenue and expenses, as well as the variances, for the event is attached. The ticketing report from the MPAC is also attached for convenience.

A total of 316 tickets were sold, and 24 complimentary tickets were issued to guests of the performing artists and the Bluegrass Heritage Foundation. The tickets were priced at \$28.50 (with \$2.00 per ticket earned by the MPAC Box Office). Gross ticket revenue was \$9,006, net ticket revenue (after MPAC ticketing fees of \$632) was \$8,374, and rent paid to the MPAC was \$552. With the McKinney Arts Commission Outreach Grant of \$3,000 included, total event revenue was \$12,006. This is approximately 26% higher than budgeted due to better-than-expected ticket sales.

Expenses were approximately 6% higher than budgeted due in part to \$232 higher total ticketing fee (a result of more tickets being sold than estimated). Actual venue rental, marketing expenses, hospitality expenses, and sound engineering expenses were otherwise reasonably close to budgeted numbers. The artist performance fees were slightly higher than budgeted due to the selection of the GRAMMY-nominated Kenny & Amanda Smith Band as part of the entertainment package. Volunteer time, a non-cash cost, is included within both the actual and budgeted numbers as directed on the McKinney Arts Commission grant request application.
