# Tax Rate Record Vote



## Purpose of Vote

- Record Vote on Proposed Tax Rate, Schedule Public Hearing, and Announce Adoption Date
  - -Vote will be required with specific wording of motion
  - -Sets ceiling for FY22 Tax Rate
- Required for proposing tax rate
- Proposed tax rate ceiling is at \$0.502500
- City Manager's recommended tax rate in the budget will be less than the tax rate ceiling



## No-New-Revenue and Voter-Approval Tax Rates

- The no-new-revenue tax rate is a calculated rate that would provide a taxing unit with the same amount of revenue it received in the year before on properties taxed in both years
- If property values rise, the no-new-revenue tax rate will go down and vice versa
- The voter-approval tax rate is 3.5% above the no-new-revenue tax rate
  - An election is required if the voter-approval tax rate is exceeded





## **Taxable Value History**




### Tax Rate

- Tax Rate has 2 parts
  - -I&S or Debt Service Rate
    - Set to match amount required to meet debt service payments in a given year
  - -M&O Tax Rate (Maintenance and Operations)
    - Funds general operational expenses (salaries and supplies)
    - Subject to no-new-revenue and voter-approval calculations
