Please note the following:

1. New Code McKinney Zoning Districts and Uses February 2021 document section 2.3.3.C.54 indicates that Manufacturing, Light uses, which fall under Light Industrial zoning, are "not to create nuisances to surrounding properties." The presence of dust, machinery noises, visible equipment, etc. are by definition nuisances to surrounding properties and the Annexation and Zoning documents must reflect the applicant's guarantee that these nuisances do not arise.

2. New Code McKinney Zoning Districts and Uses February 2021 document section 2.3.3.C.71.a.i. indicates under "C" standards for a Recycling Facility that "all storage and recycling activities shall be conducted within a fully enclosed building." This means that the material dropped off for recycling, the actual recycling activities, and the resulting recycled material storage, loading activities, etc. must all take place indoors. The Annexation and Zoning documents must reflect the applicant's confirmation/agreement to this indoor requirement.

I would like to call your attention to the minutes of the City Council Regular Meeting December 3, 2019 items 19-1011 and 19-1012, which approved a resolution, also attached, regarding cement plants in the city of McKinney.

The resolution indicates that the "Code of Ordinances ... provides for the protection of the public health and general welfare of the people of the City of McKinney." This duty, which applies regardless of nonconforming uses, clearly extends to the McKinney/other children playing outdoors at the adjacent Fairview Soccer Park.

There are 41 other types of zoning in McKinney other than Light Industrial which allow for economic growth in McKinney, real value to the Applicant, new taxable base to McKinney, and still protects the public health and general welfare duty to the people of the City of McKinney.

City Staff recommended approval of the request, and the Planning & Zoning Commission (PZ) unanimously approved the proposed rezoning request on October 22, 2019. In accordance with Subsection 146-164(5) "Negative Recommendations; Written Protest Procedures" of the Zoning Ordinance, a valid, written protest to a proposed zoning amendment, supplement, or change must be filed by the owners of at least twenty (20) percent of either the area of the lots or land covered by the proposed change or the area of the lots or land immediately adjoining the area covered by the proposed change and extending 200 feet from that area. If a valid, written protest is received by the City Secretary's Office before 5:00 p.m. on the fourth working day immediately preceding the date advertised for the City Council public hearing, the proposed zoning amendment, supplement, or change shall require a favorable vote of three-fourths of all members of the City Council.

Director of Planning Jennifer Arnold presented letters of opposition from citizens residing near the subject property and a formal petition from among qualifying properties, including several of which were delivered after the filing deadline. Director Arnold stated the number of petition entries opposing the rezone did not meet the 20 percent threshold to require a super majority favorable vote by the Council. City Attorney Mark Houser spoke to clarify the rules of petition and super majority vote regarding this request. Housing & Community Development Manager Janay Tieken and Bob Roeder, on behalf of developer NRG Group, spoke in review of the decision and procedures over the past year by the McKinney Housing Finance Corporation to secure and partner with a developer (NRP Group) on an affordable housing development.

Council unanimously approved the motion by Council member La'Shadion Shemwell, seconded by Council member Richard Franklin, to close the public hearing.

Mayor Fuller and Council Members Shemwell, Franklin and Elliott expressed support for the rezone request. The concerns and opposition by residents were acknowledged while recognizing the pressing need for affordable housing, concerns for continuing the prolong an already lengthy process for providing housing. The ability to conform to the city's strategic plan and the school district's ability to effectively accommodate imminent campus growth was also mentions as supporting factors. It was noted that the developer already has the ability by right and without the approval from Council to develop the property in a manner that would be seemingly less desirable to residents than the proposed development for which it is now requesting permission.

Mayor Pro Tem Rainey Rogers and Council Members Frazier and Philips expressed opposition to the rezone request. The need for affordable work force housing in the city was acknowledge, though concerns for not enough housing units in this project, flawed design, lack of communication from city staff, crowded schools, congested traffic, failure to enhance or promote the existing neighborhood, and negative input from citizens were mentioned as opposing factors.

This letter of intent incorporates the application for a zoning change submitted by me on June 14, 2021 on behalf of the owners of the Property, which consist of the following: (i) Kyle Ray Pierson owning an undivided 50% interest in the Property; (ii) Randy Dean Pierson owning an undivided 25% interest in the Property; and (iii) Jeffrey Hamilton, Special Trustee of the Randy Pierson Charitable Remainder Unitrust owning an undivided 25% interest in the Property. The referenced application for zoning change accompanies an annexation application relating to the Property, which is presently located in the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction of the City of McKinney, Texas. In accordance with the submittal requirements for a zoning change, the following information is set forth below:

1. The acreage of the Property is 54.152 acres as described in the Metes and Bounds description submitted with the application. Such acreage differs from that shown by the CCAD records, but is based upon an on the ground survey and as such should be the most accurate legal description of the Property. A zoning exhibit is also submitted herewith.

2. The Property is currently in the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction of the City of McKinney, Texas, therefore, the Property is not subject to existing zoning. As referenced above, a separate application requesting annexation of the Property into the corporate limits of the City of McKinney, Texas is also being submitted for review and approval.

3. The applicant requests that the Property be zoned PD – Planned Development with a base zoning of Light Industrial (LI) and the following additional uses permitted by right:

a. Rock, concrete and construction materials recycling center;

b. Dirt and topsoil storage;

c. Concrete plant, concrete batch plant, concrete block plant, fabrication or manufacture of other concrete products, pug mill operations and soil stabilization material production; and

d. Ancillary uses directly related to any of the above, including but not limited to, outdoor storage of goods and construction materials and operation of a contractor's yard.

4. The Property is currently under contract to an entity whose primary business is concrete and construction materials recycling, as well as concrete batch plant and associated activities. The addition of the above additional permitted uses will accommodate the anticipated activities of the purchaser, while restricting many of the more intense uses permitted under the HI-Heavy Industrial zone.

5. The applicant is requesting this zoning in connection with its request for annexation of the Property into the corporate limits of the City of McKinney, Texas.

6. There are no other special considerations requested or required.

7. The Property is generally located at 3403 County Road 317, McKinney, TX 75069, and fronts along the east side of County Road 317 and is south of Farm to Market Road 546.

8. The applicant requests an appearance before the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council at the earliest possible dates.

- Nitrogen oxide (NO_x) can cause or contribute to a variety of health problems and adverse environmental impacts, such as ground-level ozone, acid rain, global warming, water quality deterioration, and visual impairment. Affected populations include children, people with lung diseases such as asthma, and exposure to these conditions can cause damage to lung tissue for people who work or exercise outside.
- Sulfur dioxide (SO₂) in high concentrations can affect breathing and may aggravate existing respiratory and cardiovascular disease. Sensitive populations include asthmatics, individuals with bronchitis or emphysema, children, and the elderly.

OSHA's Respirable Crystalline Silica Standard for Construction

Workers who are exposed to respirable crystalline silica dust are at increased risk of developing serious silica-related diseases. OSHA's standard requires employers to take steps to protect workers from exposure to respirable crystalline silica.

What is Respirable Crystalline Silica?

Crystalline silica is a common mineral that is found in construction materials such as sand, stone, concrete, brick, and mortar. When workers cut, grind, drill, or crush materials that contain crystalline silica, very small dust particles are created. These tiny particles (known as "respirable" particles) can travel deep into workers' lungs and cause silicosis, an incurable and sometimes deadly lung disease. Respirable crystalline silica also causes lung cancer, other potentially debilitating respiratory diseases such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, and kidney disease. In most cases, these diseases occur after years of exposure to respirable crystalline silica.

How are Construction Workers Exposed to Respirable Crystalline Silica?

Exposure to respirable crystalline silica can occur during common construction tasks, such as using masonry saws, grinders, drills, jackhammers and handheld powered chipping tools; operating vehiclemounted drilling rigs; milling; operating crushing machines; using heavy equipment for demolition or certain other tasks; and during abrasive blasting and tunneling operations. About two million construction workers are exposed to respirable crystalline silica in over 600,000 workplaces.

What Does the Standard Require?

The standard (29 CFR 1926.1153) requires employers to limit worker exposures to respirable crystalline silica and to take other steps to protect workers. Employers can either use a control method laid out in **Table 1** of the construction standard, or they can measure workers' exposure to silica and independently decide which dust controls work best to limit exposures in their workplaces to the permissible exposure limit (PEL).

What is Table 1?

Table 1 matches 18 common construction taskswith effective dust control methods, such as usingwater to keep dust from getting into the air or usinga vacuum dust collection system to capture dust. In

some operations, respirators may also be needed. Employers who follow Table 1 correctly are not required to measure workers' exposure to silica from those tasks and are not subject to the PEL.

Table 1 Example: Handheld Power Saws

If workers are sawing silica-containing materials, they can use a saw with a built-in system that applies water to the saw blade. The water limits the amount of respirable crystalline silica that gets into the air.

In this example, if a worker uses the saw outdoors for four hours or less per day, no respirator would be needed. If a worker uses the saw for more than four
hours per day or any time indoors, he or she would need to use a respirator with an assigned protection factor (APF) of at least 10, such as a NIOSH-certified filtering facepiece respirator that covers the nose and mouth (sometimes referred to as a dust mask). See the respiratory protection standard (29 CFR 1910.134) for information on APFs.

Alternative Exposure Control Methods

Employers who do not fully implement the control methods on Table 1 must:

- Determine the amount of silica that workers are exposed to if it is, or may reasonably be expected to be, at or above the action level of 25 µg/m³ (micrograms of silica per cubic meter of air), averaged over an 8-hour day;
- Protect workers from respirable crystalline silica exposures above the PEL of 50 µg/m³, averaged over an 8-hour day;
- Use dust controls and safer work methods to protect workers from silica exposures above the PEL; and
- Provide **respirators** to workers when dust controls and safer work methods cannot limit exposures to the PEL.

What Else Does the Standard Require?

Regardless of which exposure control method is used, all construction employers covered by the standard are required to:

- Establish and implement a written exposure control plan that identifies tasks that involve exposure and methods used to protect workers, including procedures to restrict access to work areas where high exposures may occur;
- Designate a competent person to implement the written exposure control plan;
- Restrict housekeeping practices that expose workers to silica, such as use of compressed air without a ventilation system to capture the dust and dry sweeping, where effective, safe alternatives are available;
- Offer medical exams—including chest X-rays and lung function tests—every three years for workers who are required by the standard to

wear a respirator for 30 or more days per year;

- **Train workers** on the health effects of silica exposure, workplace tasks that can expose them to silica, and ways to limit exposure; and
- Keep records of workers' silica exposure and medical exams.

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McKinney moving forward to close two concrete plants despite lawsuit

The city of McKinney is moving forward with the closings of two concrete batch plants despite a federal lawsuit from the owner claiming the city's methods are illegal.

The McKinney Board of Adjustments agreed Aug. 29 that one of the plants, Martin Marietta, had until April 29, 2021, either to close or to come into compliance with the zoning ordinance for that area. The board is tentatively scheduled to consider a similar date for the CowTown Redi-Mix plant during its Sept. 30 meeting.

The two plants, CowTown Redi-Mix and Martin Marietta, produce ready-mix concrete and operate on about 10 acres along Hwy. 5.

The city has been trying to close the plants and said in court documents that it is doing so legally. The process—known as amortization—began earlier this year with the identification of

land uses that are not allowed under the current zoning, after which landowners are given a certain amount of time to shut down.

The plants' concrete operations are on land that was rezoned by the city in April 2019 for regional office use.

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However, TXI Operations, the owner of the concrete plants, has said that the city is misusing its authority "with the goal of forcing a lawful business to shut down" so that the city of McKinney "can obtain valuable property for cheap," according to the legal complaint filed with the U.S. District Court in April.

The lawsuit goes on to claim that for over two years, McKinney has illegally targeted the plant, an effort which has included saying that the plant was in violation of city code provisions because it did not have an approved site plan. The lawsuit also claims that the city arranged for multiple noise violation citations to be issued "for the purpose of harassing the Plaintiff," according to the suit. Another claim the suit makes is that the city changed the zoning for the concrete plants without providing proper notice.

"The City's goal is to force Plaintiff to close its lawful business so that the City can acquire the Property at little cost—apparently to build a park, according to City's own Parks and Open Space Master Plan," the company's complaint states.

The attorney for the concrete batch plants did not respond to requests for comment. The city of McKinney filed a motion to dismiss the case, but the court denied that motion Aug. 11 and said that TXI Operations has stated "plausible claims."

The city's response to the complaint, filed Aug. 25, denies the allegations and demands strict proof for the claims from TXI Operations. While McKinney has enforced its code of ordinances, it has not done anything illegal, the response states. The city's response further requests that all of TXI Operations claims against the city be "dismissed with prejudice," according to case documents.

According to Michael Quint, the executive director of Development Services for McKinney, the lawsuit "has less to do with the ongoing amortization processes and more to do with the city-

initiated rezoning request, which made the uses at the properties in question nonconforming."

State officials have said the plants pose no immediate health threat. Despite this, McKinney City Council initiated the amortization process at a Dec. 3 meeting with a resolution that cited the "numerous health and nuisance incidents" at the properties since 2017.

McKinney residents have filed complaints over the years about noise, light and dust pollution coming from the batch plants. Both plants are located within 500 feet of the nearest homes. In 2018, citations were issued to Martin Marietta for violating the city's noise ordinance. CowTown also has violated the city's stormwater runoff ordinances, according to Quint, and in July 2019, an estimated 8,000 pounds of cement dust were released, polluting a nearby neighborhood. Martin Marietta told state regulators that its equipment had malfunctioned.

City officials have attempted to work with the plants but have "not been able to reach an agreed solution," the December resolution stated.

To Whom It May Concern,

We the undersigned are writing to protest the proposed land use of a heavy industrial concrete manufacturing and recycling plant referenced above, known as 54.152 acres in the Richard H. Lock Survey, Abstract 517, Collin County, Texas.

Please note that this location is adjacent and abutting to Fairview Soccer Park, a city park of the Town of Fairview, which is used for soccer practice and tournaments for hundreds of children daily. The resident AYSES Club has nearly 500 minor-aged members ranging from 4 to 19 years old, over 50% of which are residents of the City of McKinney. In addition to members, Fairview Soccer Park hosts numerous tournaments and league games which bring more children, parents, and volunteers to the location throughout the year.

Concrete plants are an EPA-indicated significant source of emissions containing sulfur dioxide, nitrogen oxide, and carbon monoxide as well as dust, which affect the lungs and vision, among other things. Please note that concrete plants in TX are such polluters that there is a legislative mandate to study air quality issues if they are near schools; unfortunately, no such mandate exists for parks, but clearly this plant will not be consistent with the adjacent property use.

The McKinney City Council issued a resolution citing "numerous health and nuisance incidents" since 2017 at the existing concrete plants along Spur 399. In July of 2019, 8,000 pounds of cement dust were released, an incident that was well documented. The City Council cannot accept such a risk when the health and well being of minors is at stake.

We are confident now that this issue has been raised, the City Council will recognize that this proposal should not proceed and will vote against it.
