The McKinney Public Library System Advisory Board met in regular session in the Conference Room of the John and Judy Gay Library, 6861 W. Eldorado Parkway, McKinney, Texas on October 18, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

Chairman Peter Samsury called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. after determining a quorum was present.

After review of specific polices pertaining to library service delivery to McKinney's homeless population, the Homeless Services Team determined no changes are needed for the library's Code of Conduct. The team will continue to monitor the needs of this population to determine if policies need to be changed. After interviewing and surveying staff of the library, the Homeless Services Team determined that onboarding and training resources should include: Sensitivity training,

and guidelines for what behaviors require a verbal warning, dismissal from

the facility, or criminal trespass. The Homeless Services Team has

created a comprehensive Community Resource pamphlet that lists local

resources and organizations serving the homeless population specific to

McKinney. The Community Resource pamphlet is available at both

libraries, and are easily accessible to all and any patrons who want to take

one. Library Staff members have been made aware of this resource and

its location on Library Commons. The Community Resource pamphlet will

be shared with other city departments such as, MPAC and Parks and

Recreations.

18-897 Chairman Samsury called for the Director's Report. Library Director,

Spencer Smith, presented an Annual Report of fiscal year 2018 on the

McKinney Public Library System. Fiscal Year 2018 saw another record

breaking year for circulation and adult program attendance. The year also

saw a decrease in youth program attendance and corresponding library

visits. Our staff reorganization in FY19 aims to address this.

Board members unanimously approved the motion by Board member Smith-

Carter, seconded by Board member Closs, to adjourn. Chairman Samsury adjourned
