Sale Of Parkland We need to learn a lot more about the proposed use of the land before many of us could get behind the sale enough to vote for it in November. . This property is close to the heard

1. 20-0654 bylaws of the MHFC

I'm concerned about the changes, specifically the one where the finances don't need to be included in the regular minutes submitted to the City Council. Why not?

Can you clarify the language of whether the city can reappropriate the MHFC money or not? I can't tell with this wording.

The MHFC is going to have millions coming in over a long stretch of time, what happens when this project is complete and there's no longer a need for an outside accounting firm? Why is there no language in this revision that makes it clear who will be in charge of the finances once there is no longer an outside firm doing the books? The books should go back to the city when this is over and it should be clearly stated in the bylaws.

2. 20-0656 sale of parkland on ballot

Where did this come from? I know it wasn't an item when this same thing had to go through approval for the May election. I am against the sale, especially if it is for industrial/manufacturing purposes as I've heard from someone close to the concrete batch plant issue.

This land backs into the Heard Wildlife Sanctuary. When we were dealing with all the cement plant issues, an employee at the Heard came to speak at a meeting saying they were already getting cement dust runoff feeding right into the Heard's water system. Now, you want to sell the land for purposes that might make the pollution worse? We need to learn a lot more about the proposed use of the land before we'd vote yes in November.

Bridgette Wallis, Kensington Ln, McKinney TX 75072

On the city website, we're actively discouraged from coming to City Council meetings due to the virus. Now, we cannot have our voices heard from home about important matters on the agenda until they are published in the minutes AFTER the meeting has taken place and important public hearings have taken place. What is the point? Also, there is nothing in writing on the city website that says that the comments we submit through the online portal ever get to the city council members (or members of any of the other boards) prior to meetings. How does this new system foster citizen participation? How does this new system help or improve communication in any way?
