

CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION

SEPTEMBER 1, 2020

The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas met in work session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas on Tuesday, September 1, 2020, at 3:00 p.m.

There were six (6) members of the public present.

Mayor Fuller called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m. upon determining a quorum of the City Council was present.

Mayor Fuller called for public comments on agenda items. There were none.

Mayor Fuller called for the discussion of the agenda items to be presented at the City Council Regular Meeting of Tuesday, September 1, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.

Director of Engineering Gary Graham and City Attorney Mark Houser spoke regarding agenda item #20-0764 (Consider/Discuss/Act on Adoption of a Resolution Determining a Public Necessity to Acquire Certain Properties (in Fee Simple) for Public Use by Eminent Domain and Associated with the East Louisiana Public Parking Project and Said Certain Properties are Legally Known as Lots 1, 2A, 2C & 3 of the Andrews Addition and Lot/Outlots 1A and 1B of the George A Wilson Addition, an Addition to the City of McKinney, Collin County Texas Generally Located Between East Louisiana

Street and Anthony Street and Authorizing the City Manager to Establish Procedures for Acquiring the Properties in Fee Simple, and Take All Steps Necessary to Acquire the Needed Property Rights in Compliance with all Applicable Laws and Resolutions).

Mayor Fuller called for Council Liaison updates regarding the McKinney Board and Commissions.

Council Member Philips stated the Library Advisory Board is performing well and noted six thousand (6,000) library cards have been issued during the COVID-19 pandemic; and commended city staff for the work of the Architect Selection Team, in which he also was involved.

Council Member Elliott stated the McKinney Community Development Corporation (MCDC) is working on several new projects and expressed appreciation for the level of community engagement and cooperation taking place.

Council Member Frazier agreed with Council Member Elliott regarding MCDC.

Council Member Shemwell announced the next meeting of the North Central Texas Emergency Communications District Board, of which is he the representative for the City of McKinney. The meeting will be Wednesday, September 3, 2020.

Mayor Fuller sought consensus among the Council to implement the “Paint the Town Blue” program, to illuminate the water tower blue in honor of the police.
