



- On September 8, 2016 PROS Board recommended the name Dr. Mack Hill Park for a 16-acre park site at 1849 Regan Drive.
- On September 20, 2016 City Council approved the name Dr. Mack Hill for the park site located at 1849 Reagan Drive.
- During the naming process for Dr. Mack Hill Park a second name, George Webb Park, was also considered.
- The PROS Board requested that the name George Webb Park be brought back for consideration for a future park name.
- George Webb has lived and operated a business in the City of McKinney since 1951. As a member of the McKinney Jaycees, he led efforts to open the first recreation center in McKinney. He is a former Chairman of the McKinney Parks, Recreation and Open Space Advisory Board.
- George Webb has twice been awarded the McKinney Chamber of Commerce Citizen of the Year in 1954 and 2005. He was also awarded the McKinney Community Development Corporations Quality of Life Award in 2007.
